NoRTEC is required to provide a two-year update to the 2021-2024 Regional and Local Plans. The purpose of the update is to ensure the plans remain current and account for changes in labor market and economic conditions or in other factors affecting the implementation of the local plan, such as consistency with policy direction of the State Plan. The Plan update will address changes in the economy since COVID-19 and recent natural disasters and the resulting disparities these impacts have had on the region's unserved and underserved communities. The updated economic and workforce trends will be used to analyze the system of services currently in existence, identify gaps and the review the status of collaborative efforts across State, regional and local partners.

Specifically, NoRTEC is required to update the local and regional plans to address coordination between our WIOA required partners and other State strategic partners including:

- County Health and Human Services Agencies and other local partners who serve individuals who access CalFresh Employment and Training services.
- Local Child Support Agencies and other local partners who service individuals who are non-custodial parents.
- Local partners who serve individuals with developmental and intellectual disabilities.
- Local partners who serve individuals who are English language learners, foreign-born, and/or refugees.

- Other entities supporting historically unserved or underserved communities.

NoRTEC invites public comment on any of the above areas. The input from the community will be taken into consideration in later meetings with the relevant stakeholders and partner organizations.
