1. Can demonstrate familiarity with industry-specific tools and equipment and their use, including basic hand tools, bolt cutters, and basic welding equipment. (R, T)
2. Can demonstrate proper techniques used to dismantle wrecked vehicles and remove useable parts. (R, S, T)
3. Can demonstrate proper technique used to clean salvaged parts, using solvents and brush, or vapor-decreasing machine. (R, S, T)
